

ZEPHYRHILLS MUNICIPAL AIRPORT ADVISORY BOARD MEETING

November 20th, 2023

A Regular Airport Advisory Board meeting was held on November 20th, 2023 at 4:00 p.m. in the City of Zephyrhills Council Chambers. Buzz Hohmann called the meeting to order. The members present were Buzz Hohmann, Erik Meredith, Matthew Laseter, David Inman and Kenneth Leslie. Dan Evans and Bill Castle were absent. City staff included Airport Manager Nathan Coleman and Executive Administrative Assistant Lucy Huber.

APPROVAL/CORRECTION OF MINUTES

1. Matt Laseter moved to approve the minutes from the 08-21-2023 board meeting. Ken Leslie seconded and the motion passed

AIRPORT MANAGERS REPORT

1. Jacobs Engineering sent over the most recent renderings of the new FBO and these were displayed for the airport board to review. The group went over the plans and discussion ensued. Mr. Coleman explained that the \$6,600,000.00 State approved appropriation is slated for specific projects. Those projects are the new FBO, 2 box hangars and Taxiway F. With current inflated construction costs, the approved appropriation total will not be enough to complete the projects as originally planned. The original square footage for the FBO was 8,000 square feet, but it has been lowered to 6,500. This amount of space still leaves room for expansion as the airport grows. The square footage of the 2 box hangars has also been cut from 10,000 square feet each, to 3,600. The Design phase for Taxiway Foxtrot will be completed, but the construction phase will have to wait.

FUEL SALES

Fuel sales were reviewed, no action taken.
