MAYOR'S YOUTH COUNCIL

Sec. 30.140. Creation.

There is hereby created a board to be known as the Mayor's Youth Council, which shall consist of seven members. The members will be Zephyrhills area residents who are actively enrolled in a public, charter, or private high school or middle school, or home schooled in grades 6 through 12. The members shall be appointed by the City Council and each member appointed shall serve a term of two years, except that of the seven members first appointed, three shall serve for a term of three years, four shall serve for a term of two years, ending at the conclusion of the current school year that their term expires. The terms of members of the Mayor's Youth Council will remain staggered and will expire and be appointed in August. If the Mayor's Youth Council fails to operate as a Council for more than six months, the Mayor can call for the appointment of all new members at any time and the new member's terms will be reduced by the time served from the date of appointment to the following August. The Mayor will attend meetings along with city staff and shall coordinate the youth council activities.

Sec. 30.141. Selection of officers.

The Mayor's Youth Council shall elect a Chair to conduct meetings and a Vice Chair to conduct meetings in the absence of the Chair. Elections shall be held at the first regular meeting after annual appointments are made by the City Council.

Sec. 30.142. Vacancies.

Irregular vacancies on the Mayor's Youth Council shall be filled as they occur and regular vacancies shall be filled by appointment in June of each year.

Sec. 30.143. Meetings; records.

The Mayor's Youth Council shall hold at least one regular meeting quarterly. Public record of such meetings shall be kept by the Office of the City Clerk. All meetings shall be public under State Sunshine Law regulations.

Sec. 30.144. Absences from meetings.

Absence from three consecutive regular meetings of the Mayor's Youth Council shall operate to vacate a seat of a member, unless such absence is excused by the Board by majority vote, with such excuse duly entered upon its minutes.

Sec. 30.145. Duties and responsibilities.

The Mayor's Youth Council shall have the duty and responsibility to:

- (A) Evaluate and review problems facing youth in the city.
- (B) Facilitate neighborhood meetings with youth to discuss problems, needs, and suggested improvements for our community.
- (C) Meet regularly with the Mayor to share ideas and discuss issues, concerns, and needed improvements.
- (D) Attend City Council meetings.
- (E) Present recommended improvements to the Mayor, City Council and City Manager of public projects and programs.
- (F) Assist in planning youth/recreation activities.
- (G) Evaluate and advise the Mayor, City Council and/or City Manager on issues forwarded to the Mayor's Youth Council for advice.
