Council President Kenneth M. Burgess, Jr. called the meeting to order at 6:02 p.m. Roll call was taken. Present were members Kenneth Burgess, Jodi Wilkeson, Steven F. Spina, Ph.D., Lance A. Smith and Mayor Melonie Bahr Monson. City Attorney Matthew Maggard and City Manager William Poe were also present. Charles Proctor was absent.

Jodi Wilkeson moved to accept the addition of the mayor's emergency item. Seconded by Lance Smith. Motion passed unanimously 4-0.

Lance Smith moved to approve consent items as presented. Seconded by Jodi Wilkeson. Motion passed unanimously 4-0.

****EMERGENCY ITEM****

A.D. Morgan presented their Gross Maximum Price (GMP) review for SVB indoor sports complex with alternate options for Council to select from.

City Manager William Poe reminded Council that this project is funded by state appropriation and a developer who made contribution dollars that can only be spent on the tennis center. Discussion followed.

Lance Smith moved to accept staff recommendation of GMP base plus alternates 1 and 5. Seconded by Steven Spina. Motion passed, 3-1 opposed Jodi Wilkeson.

2. BUSINESS ITEMS/PUBLIC HEARINGS

2.1 AdventHealth Future Land Use and Rezoning

Second Reading **ORDINANCE NO. 1480-24 - "AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ZEPHYRHILLS, FLORIDA APPROVING A SMALL SCALE FUTURE LAND USE MAP AMENDMENT TO THE CITY'S COMPREHENSIVE PLAN, CHANGING THE FUTURE LAND USE CLASSIFICATION FROM P/SP (PUBLIC/SEMI-PUBLIC) AND MU (MIXED USE) TO RU (RESIDENTIAL URBAN); AND AMENDING THE CITY'S OFFICIAL ZONING MAP, CHANGING THE ZONING DESIGNATION FROM PUD (PLANNED UNITED DEVELOPMENT) AND OP (OFFICE PROFESSIONAL) TO PUD (PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT), FOR PARCEL 35-25-21-0010-08500-0010 AND A PORTION OF PARCEL 35-25-21-0010-06900-0020; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION, SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE."**

City Attorney Matthew Maggard read Ordinance No. 1480-24 by title.

Council President Burgess opened a public hearing.

Planning Director Todd Vande Berg provided background to this item focusing on issues that have been discussed, such as the traffic study recommendation of one turn lane, the conditions that have been added to the ordinance tying a future builder to a tree preservation table, additional turn lanes and working with the grades of the parcel as much as possible. Staff will also review some architectural elements with a future builder.

Lance Smith asked what staff required for transportation improvements.

Todd said intersection improvements at Pretty Pond Wire Rd are in final design and Staff is reviewing. The Engineer will coordinate with Pasco County to get county right of way use permit. The additional turn lanes onto Pretty Pond and Wire Road will help keep traffic moving.

Steven Spina asked if the maximum number of units is 250 which Todd confirmed is true but after tree preservation and design engineering that will likely come down.

Council President Burgess said the applicant has committed to advising any perspective buyer of the conditions and concerns discussed by Council.

Lance Smith asked if architectural design and site plan approval was included in the conditions which Todd confirmed they were.

Council President Burgess closed the public hearing.

Lance Smith moved to approve Ordinance No. 1480-24 on the Second Reading. Seconded by Jodi Wilkeson. Motion passed unanimously, 4-0.

2.2 Providence Village Annexation

Second Reading **ORDINANCE NO. 1482-24 - "AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ZEPHYRHILLS, FLORIDA ANNEXING ADDITIONAL TERRITORY TO**

BE INCLUDED WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF SAID CITY DESCRIBED AS 37518 GEIGER ROAD, ZEPHYRHILLS, FL 33542 ZEPHYRHILLS, FLORIDA 33542 IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 171.044, FLORIDA STATUTES, AS AMENDED."

City Attorney Matthew Maggard read Ordinance No. 1482-24 by title.

Council President Burgess opened a public hearing.

Planning Director Todd Vande Berg provided background to this item including steps that have been taken to address the transportation and geological concerns.

Council President Burgess said this is a project that has had a lot of discussion with concerns that Council has asked the petitioner to be cognizant of.

Discussion followed regarding tree restrictions, environmental reports, water use clause and Geiger Road improvements.

***Norman Scheuerman – 37604 Geiger Road - spoke from the floor -

Mr. Scheuerman said in addition to his water, geological and traffic concerns, if the property is sold, the new owner cannot be held to the agreements made today. With the addition of homes and people that these projects will bring it, it will impact the traffic. Mr. Scheuerman also said he did not trust geological consultants paid for by a developer as that might influence their results. Mr. Scheuerman ended by encouraging Council to make a decision they are willing to live with.

Discuss followed regarding zoning and the conditions within the ordinance.

***Bryan Dion – 400 N Ashton Street, Tampa FL - spoke from the floor -

Mr. Dion said he was present on behalf of the applicant. He said the applicant is requesting a lower density not higher and that they will be contributing to the sidewalk development. Mr. Dion said that if the applicant wants to put more properties on the land they will need to return before Council and answer why they are asking for more.

Discuss followed regarding density on the property.

***Tina Smith – 5945 Plaza View Dr. - spoke from the floor -

Mrs. Smith echoed Mr. Scheuerman's concerns about the safety of Geiger Road. Mrs. Smith said she added bushes to the side of her property after being shown tire tracks coming off the road. Mrs. Smith shared a story of a neighbor who tripped and fell avoiding a car on Geiger. She said Geiger has not been paved in over 20 years but fears that drivers will go faster if it is paved. She is concerned that with more homes bringing more drivers this road will become more dangerous. Mrs. Smith said she is considering moving if conditions do not improve.

Council President Burgess closed the public hearing.

Discussion followed regarding placing safety features on Geiger Road, the developer assisting with putting a sidewalk in, the proximity of this development to schools and Councils attempt to address concerns while respecting private property rights.

Steven Spina said that these projects are affecting the makeup of the community and he asked for a visioning session to address the moratorium until the City's water use permit is in place.

Discussion continued regarding how the City will be affected by projects within our boundaries and projects in Pasco County who share our roads and how Council can be more mindful of resident needs with its decisions where the County may not be as aware. It was noted the City does not have a timeframe on the update to the water use permit but it is being worked on.

Lance Smith moved to approve Ordinance No. 1482-24 on the Second Reading. Seconded by Jodi Wilkeson. Motion passed unanimously, 4-0.

City Attorney Matthew Maggard read Ordinance No. 1483-24 by title.

Council President Burgess opened a public hearing.

Norman Scheuerman carries over his comments from item 2.2.

Council President Burgess closed the public hearing.

Lance Smith moved to approve Ordinance No. 1483-24 on the Second Reading. Seconded by Jodi Wilkeson. Motion passed unanimously, 4-0.

2.4 Black Marlin Annexation

Second Reading **ORDINANCE NO. 1485-24 - "AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ZEPHYRHILLS, FLORIDA ANNEXING ADDITIONAL TERRITORY TO BE INCLUDED WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF SAID CITY DESCRIBED AS PARCEL NUMBER 03-26-21-0010-11700-0020 ZEPHYRHILLS FLORIDA 33542 IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 171.044, FLORIDA STATUTES, AS AMENDED."**

City Attorney Matthew Maggard read Ordinance No. 1485-24 by title.

Council President Burgess opened a public hearing.

Principal Planner Rodney Corriveau gave background on this project. Rodney said that many of the same issues from item 2.2 & 2.3 are also applicable to item 2.4. Rodney noted that the WaterStar Certification is built into the Land Development Code.

***Tina Smith – 5945 Plaza View Dr. - spoke from the floor -

Mrs. Smith said regarding water us that her home and driveway have shifted in the last several years due to the lack of ground water. She borrowed her neighbor's hose, connected to City water so she didn't have to use her well. Mrs. Smith said that she is very concerned about the amount of units being proposed to be built in the small amount of space.

Council President Burgess closed the public hearing.

Discussion followed. It was noted that Geiger Road is a County Road and was not slated for improvement for at least 5 years until Council and Staff pressed the need for improvements which should be done within a year.

Jodi Wilkeson moved to approve Ordinance No. 1485-24 on the Second Reading. Seconded by Lance Smith. Motion passed unanimously, 4-0.

Second Reading **ORDINANCE NO. 1486-24 - "AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ZEPHYRHILLS, FLORIDA PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE CITY'S COMPREHENSIVE PLAN, PROVIDING FOR A SMALL-SCALE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN AMENDMENTS TO THE FUTURE LAND USE MAP CHANGING FROM R-1 MH (PASCO COUNTY) TO RS (RESIDENTIAL SUBURBAN) AND THE ZONING DESIGNATION FROM PASCO COUNTY RMH TO CITY R-3 (MEDIUM DENSITY RESIDENTIAL) FOR APPROXIMATELY 4.155 ACRES OF REAL PROPERTY HAVING PARCEL NUMBER 03-26-21-0010-11700-0020, PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION, SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE."**

City Attorney Matthew Maggard read Ordinance No. 1486-24 by title.

Council President Burgess opened a public hearing.

***Norman Scheuerman – 37604 Geiger Road - spoke from the floor -

Mr. Scheuerman said that that he believes this item will pass and he wants Council to act on the desire to measure the growth responsibly without delay.

Council President Burgess said that he appreciates Mr. Scheuerman and Mrs. Smith coming out to speak, many meetings go by with no comments from the citizens.

Council President Burgess closed the public hearing.

Lance Smith moved to approve Ordinance No. 1486-24 on the Second Reading. Seconded by Jodi Wilkeson. Motion passed unanimously, 4-0.

2.6 Gagne PUD Indoor Storage with Mixed Use Development

Second Reading **ORDINANCE NO. 1489-24 - "AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ZEPHYRHILLS, FLORIDA, APPROVING A REZONING - PUD (PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT) MASTER PLAN AMENDMENT TO THE GAGNE – CHANCEY ROAD PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT FOR THE PROPERTY**

IDENTIFIED AS 3356 PAUL S BUCHMAN HIGHWAY, ZEPHYRHILLS, FL 33540; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION, SEVERABILITY, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE."

City Attorney Matthew Maggard read Ordinance No. 1489-24 by title.

Council President Burgess opened a public hearing.

Todd VandeBerg provided background to this item. Todd stated that if Council approved the PUD masterplan amendment, then the applicant would return with an engineered site plan along with landscape and irrigation plans.

Council President Burgess closed the public hearing.

Steven Spina moved to approve Ordinance No. 1489-24 on the Second Reading. Seconded by Jodi Wilkeson. Motion passed unanimously, 4-0.

3. PLANNING DIRECTOR'S REPORT

3.1 Bauducco Foods Conditional Use

Planning Director Todd VandeBerg presented the Bauducco Foods Conditional Use submittal for approval to change maximum allowable building height.

Greg Crawford with Florida Engineering Group presented the site plan for the Bauducco Foods factory.

Toby Walker, President of Walker Design and architect of record for Bauducco Foods, presented to Council the architecture design plans for the new building.

Discussion followed. Council was please with the design presented and positive impact it will have on the industrial corridor and City.

Todd said in closing that Staff did recommend the approval of the conditional use. Bauducco will bring 500 jobs, and the proposed residential projects will provide housing for the employees because we want them to live and work in the City, not to commute from surrounding areas.

Lance Smith moved to approve Bauducco Foods Conditional Use. Seconded by Jodi Wilkeson. Motion passed unanimously, 4-0.

3.2 5L Property Annexation, FLUMA

Principal Planner Rodney Corriveau presented the proposed annexation and future land use of the 5L Property. Staff requested consensus to move forward and direct the City Attorney to write the ordinance.

Council gave unanimous consensus for 5L Property Annexation and FLUMA, 4-0.

CITIZEN COMMENTS

*** Kyle Salvato with Skydive City – spoke from the floor -
Mr. Salvato provided an update on Skydive City and its Skydive First Project.

*** Kim Earle – 37741 Phelps Road - spoke from the floor -
Mrs. Earle spoke regarding flooding in her neighborhood from Trotters Crossing. Mrs. Earle said the retention pond flooded into her property again. She asked if the engineer or builder messed up and why does it keeps happening.
Council and Staff discussed with Mrs. Earle about her flood concerns and the upcoming meeting that is scheduled for Monday.

MAYOR ANNOUNCEMENTS – NONE

CITY MANAGER ANNOUNCEMENTS

City Manager William Poe gave an update on the flooding situation in Abbott Square and Lennar's commitment to correct it.

Discussion followed.

Jodi Wilkeson said we are counting on our developer partners to do what they say they are going to do and if they do not, we should say they do not get another chance.

Mike Almeida – 36500 Smith Feild Lane - spoke from the floor to this topic -
Mr. Almeida said that he is a licensed civil engineer with expertise in drainage and stormwater ponds. Mr. Almeida said that according to the engineers' report, the ponds are working as designed, with tests run for a 100-year storm for 120 hours. Mr. Almeida does not believe this is accurate as four of the six ponds discharged during a tropical storm. There is also water intrusion into backyard patios.

Discussion followed with Amber Smith, Public Affairs Manager from SWFWMD, commenting as well.

Mr. Almeida also expressed concerns about a 12-foot hole that was added later and not part of the original plans as well as the CDD's unwillingness to act on repairs and fixes that need to be done.

City Attorney Matthew Maggard agreed to reach out to the CDD lawyer regarding ownership, responsibility and performance bond.

City Manager William Poe said the City is still working on the Water Use Permit response. On September 10th there is a Pasco Eastside Joint Conference. Regarding park dollars there is \$50,000 left of \$300,000 that was encumbered this year.

Approval to purchase seven patrol vehicles - Police Department

Issue:

The purchase request is to continue replacing older vehicles with high mileage and/or recurring maintenance issues.

Background:

The police department prefers to continue purchasing SUVs to provide greater flexibility due to their ability to handle various terrains and weather conditions. Their higher ground clearance and all-wheel-drive options allow for easier navigation on unpaved roads or flooded areas, which can be critical for reaching remote or hard-to-access locations. In addition, police SUVs offer more cargo space than sedans, accommodating the essential equipment needed for emergencies. This includes medical supplies, firearms, riot gear, and roadside equipment that are often difficult to fit comfortably in a sedan. SUVs generally have a sturdier frame and higher safety ratings in collisions compared to sedans. The enhanced durability is essential for police departments, as vehicles are subject to high wear and tear due to the demands of 24/7 patrols, pursuits, and off-road incidents. Lastly, law enforcement personnel often spend long hours in their vehicles, and SUVs offer more interior space, including greater legroom, headroom, and seat adjustability. This comfort especially benefits officers wearing bulky equipment or larger/taller personnel.

Fiscal Impact:

Listed in the FY25 police department budget is the acquisition of seven (7) patrol vehicles utilizing Penny for Pasco funding. Police vehicles will be purchased through Bartow Ford using the cooperative purchasing agreement of Charlotte County Contract #2021000541. Pricing includes accessories and installation of radios at \$60,079.19 per vehicle. Radios needed to outfit the cars will be obtained through Williams Communications, Inc. under the Florida-Sourcwell/L3Harris Public Safety Contract #042021-L3H at approximately \$3,301.11 per radio. Axon Enterprise, Inc. will install the in-car camera system under Sourcwell Contract #010720-AXN (Quote #Q-584881-45545.569RG) into a new 120-month term, a combined FY25 cost of \$14,159.88 per

year or \$2,022.84 per unit.

The cost per vehicle, including equipment, is \$65,403.14 per unit, for a total of \$457,821.98 for the seven cars. The purchase of two administrative vehicles will be presented at a future meeting.

If purchased by the AGENCY, on such dates and times mutually agreed upon by the parties, AXON will install and configure into AGENCY's existing network a wireless network infrastructure as identified in the AGENCY's binding quote based on conditions of the sale.

VEHICLE INSTALLATION

Preparedness

On such dates and times mutually agreed upon by the parties, the AGENCY will deliver all vehicles to an AXON Installer less weapons and items of evidence. Vehicle(s) will be deemed 'out of service' to the extent necessary to perform Work pursuant of this SOW.

Existing Mobile Video Camera System Removal

On such dates and times mutually agreed upon by the parties, the AGENCY will deliver all vehicles to an AXON Installer which will remove from said vehicles all components of the existing mobile video camera system unless otherwise agreed upon by the AGENCY.

Major components will be salvaged by the AXON Installer for auction by the AGENCY. Wires and cables are not considered expendable and will not be salvaged. Salvaged components will be placed in a designated area by the AGENCY within close proximity of the vehicle in an accessible work space.

Prior to removing the existing mobile video camera systems, it is both the responsibility of the AGENCY and the AXON Installer to test the vehicle's systems' operation to identify and operate, documenting any existing component or system failures and in detail, identify which components of the existing mobile video camera system will be removed by the AXON Installer.

In-Car Hardware/Software Delivery and Installation

On such dates and times mutually agreed upon by the parties, the AGENCY will deliver all vehicles to an AXON Installer, who will install and configure in each vehicle in accordance with the specifications detailed in the system's installation manual and its relevant addendum(s). Applicable in-car hardware will be installed and configured as defined and validated by the AGENCY during the pre-deployment discovery process.

If a specified vehicle is unavailable on the date and time agreed upon by the parties, AGENCY will provide a similar vehicle for the installation process. Delays due to a vehicle, or substitute vehicle, not being available at agreed upon dates and times may result in additional fees to the AGENCY. If the AXON Installer determines that a vehicle is not properly prepared for installation ("Not Fleet Ready"), such as a battery not being properly charged or properly up-fit for in-service, field operations, the issue shall be reported immediately to the AGENCY for resolution and a date and time for the future installation shall be agreed upon by the parties.

Upon completion of installation and configuration, AXON will systematically test all installed and configured in-car hardware and software to ensure that ALL functions of the hardware and software are fully operational and that any deficiencies are corrected unless otherwise agreed upon by the AGENCY, installation, configuration, test and the correct of any deficiencies will be completed in each vehicle accepted for installation.

Prior to installing the Axon Fleet camera systems, it is both the responsibility of the AGENCY and the AXON Installer to test the vehicle's existing systems' operation to identify, document any existing component or vehicle systems' failures. Prior to any vehicle up-fitting the AXON Installer will introduce the system's components, basic functions, integrations and systems overview along with reference to AXON approved, AGENCY manuals, guides, portals and videos. It is both the responsibility of the AGENCY and the AXON Installer to agree on placement of each components, the antenna(s), integration recording trigger sources and customer preferred power, ground and ignition sources prior to permanent or temporary installation of an Axon Fleet camera solution in each vehicle type. Agreed placement will be documented by the AXON Installer.

AXON welcomes up to 5 persons per system operation training session per day, and unless otherwise agreed upon by the AGENCY, the first vehicle will be used for an installation training demonstration. The second vehicle will be used for an assisted installation training demonstration. The installation training session is customary to any AXON Fleet installation service regardless of who performs the continued Axon Fleet system installations.

The customary training session does not 'certify' a non-AXON Installer, customer-employed Installer or customer 3rd party Installer, since the AXON Fleet products does not offer an Installer certification program. Any work performed by non-AXON Installer, customer-employed Installer or customer 3rd party Installer is not warranted by AXON, and AXON is not liable for any damage to the vehicle and its existing systems and AXON Fleet hardware.

CONSENT ITEMS 2.6

Canine Transfer of Ownership

Issue:

Due to Canine Bolt's retirement, the city is prepared to transfer ownership to his handler, Officer Emile Limoges.

Background:

Transferring ownership to the canine's handler is the most compassionate and practical choice when a law enforcement canine retires. This decision benefits both the retiring canine and the agency in multiple ways, providing a safe, stable, and familiar environment for the animal while reducing liability and costs for the agency. Law enforcement canines are highly trained and form deep bonds with their handlers, often living with them full-time. Upon retirement, transitioning to a new or unknown setting can cause stress and confusion for the canine. By transferring ownership to the handler, the dog remains in a familiar, stable home, minimizing stress and allowing it to retire comfortably with the people it trusts. Allowing them to stay with handlers who understand their training ensures the canine is appropriately supervised, minimizing any risk to the public that could arise if the animal were released to an unqualified individual.

CANINE OWNERSHIP TRANSFER AGREEMENT

THIS CANINE OWNERSHIP TRANSFER AGREEMENT is made this 25th day of November 2024 by and between the CITY OF ZEPHYRHILLS, FLORIDA (hereinafter "CITY") and EMILE LIMOGES, an officer of the Zephyrhills Police Department (hereinafter "OFFICER").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, CITY currently has within its K-9 corps a certain canine named "BOLT," hereafter referred to as "CANINE," and

WHEREAS, CITY desires to retire CANINE from active service with its police department and

WHEREAS, OFFICER was the sole handler assigned to CANINE, who cared for and maintained CANINE in OFFICER'S home during off-duty hours and

WHEREAS, OFFICER desires and has requested the CITY transfer ownership of, and complete responsibility for, CANINE to OFFICER and

WHEREAS, CITY is willing to transfer ownership of, and complete responsibility for, CANINE to OFFICER, provided OFFICER is willing to defend, hold harmless, and indemnify CITY, its officers, and employees from any and all loss, injury, or damage caused by CANINE after the effective date of this agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

1. CITY shall transfer sole ownership of, and complete responsibility for, CANINE to OFFICER on November 25, 2024.

2. In consideration of the transfer, OFFICER accepts sole ownership of, and complete responsibility for, CANINE, including responsibility for the maintenance, health care, supervision, and control of CANINE, without reimbursement or compensation from CITY.

3. Further, in return for CITY'S conveying ownership of CANINE to OFFICER, OFFICER warrants that he will defend and hold harmless CITY, its officers, and employees from any and all claims for injury or damage of whatever kind, caused or alleged to have been caused by CANINE after the date of transfer set forth herein, whether OFFICER or any other person, is deemed negligent or alleged to have been negligent or not.

4. OFFICER further warrants that he will indemnify CITY, its officers, and employees for any loss (including costs, expenses, and attorney fees) that CITY, its officers, or employees may suffer as a result of the claims mentioned in Paragraph 3.

5. The parties further agree that CITY is relying on these representations by OFFICER in agreeing to this transfer and that, but for said representations, CITY would not be willing to transfer ownership of, and responsibility for, CANINE to OFFICER.

6. This agreement and all of its provisions shall continue until the death of CANINE.

7. This agreement shall constitute the sole and only understanding between the parties hereto with respect to the subject matter herein, and no other warranties, representations, or terms of any kind exist except as set forth herein.

CITY MANAGER'S REPORT 3.1

Generator Purchase for the Police Department

Issue:

The ZPD is requesting the City Council's support in funding this critical upgrade to ensure the department can meet its commitments to public safety, even in the face of severe weather and extended outages.

Background:

The Police Department is seeking support from the City Council to purchase a new generator to ensure reliable power in the event of future outages. Over twenty-one years old, the current generator shows signs of wear that have increasingly impacted its reliability, as was made clear during Hurricane Milton. During the storm, the generator struggled to fully power the building, leading to operational difficulties at a critical time when public safety responsibilities were heightened. Hurricane Milton exposed the limitations of the aging generator, which required constant monitoring and repair to function and could not sustain the power needed for critical systems and communications. The generator's deficiencies left essential services at risk, jeopardizing our ability to respond promptly and effectively to emergencies. In such situations, dependable power is necessary for ensuring seamless communications, maintaining surveillance and security systems, and providing a safe environment for personnel responding to crises around the clock. Investing in a new generator is a matter of operational efficiency and safety. With a reliable power source, the police department can remain fully operational during emergencies, fulfilling its commitment to protecting the community and maintaining order. Additionally, a new generator would reduce maintenance costs, mitigate the risk of operational failure, and extend the building's power backup capabilities to better handle the demands of policing and emergency management.

Fiscal Impact:

The department received a quote from RCM Utilities, LLC, for \$111,300 to replace the generator. The city of Zephyrhills has a continuing service contract with RCM Utilities, which is valid until August 1, 2025. The contract allows RCM to perform work or task orders, eliminating the need to obtain additional quotes. The Finance Department has recommended using the Police Impact Fee Contingency Fund to pay for the project. Since the lead time for ordering a generator is about a year, replacing the current generator is critical before the 2025 Storm Season.

Dates by which performance obligations are scheduled to be met will be extended for a period equal to the time lost due to any delay so caused. Contractor's failure to perform any term or condition of this Contract because of conditions beyond its control mentioned herein or other conditions that cause delay, damage, or destruction of its work by others shall not be deemed a breach of this Contract.

Material Escalation. The Contract Price for this Project has been calculated based on the current prices for the component building materials. However, the market for these building materials is considered volatile and sudden price increases could occur. Contractor agrees to use its best efforts to obtain the lowest possible prices from available building material suppliers but should there be an increase in the prices of these materials that are purchased after execution of this Contract for use in this Project, then Owner or General Contractor agrees and shall pay the substantiated cost increase to Contractor. Any request or change order for payment of a

cost increase shall state the increased cost, the building materials in question, and the source of supply, supported by invoices or bills of sale.

1. This proposal is an offer to enter into a contract, with the mutual promises contained herein constituting valuable and sufficient consideration. The execution of this proposal by the owner listed above (the "Owner") shall constitute acceptance of the offer and formation of contract (the "Contract") between the Owner (the "Owner") and RCM Utilities, LLC. The terms set forth herein, including those after the acceptance signature below and/or on subsequent pages, shall govern the Contract.
2. Warranty. The Contractor warrants all supplied materials and workmanship to be free of defects for a period of one year after installation. The Contractor warrants that materials and equipment furnished under the Contract will be new and good quality.
3. Payment. The Contractor will invoice the Owner in accordance with the schedule set forth above or, if no terms are set forth above, monthly for work performed during each calendar month. The Owner agrees that there shall be no retainage except as set forth in the schedule above. Payment is due within 30 days of the date of invoice. Thereafter, monthly finance charges of 1.5% or the maximum allowed by law, whichever is less, will be assessed on unpaid amounts.
4. Time. The Contractor shall achieve substantial completion of the work within a commercially reasonable time. At the Owner's request, the Contractor shall submit for information a construction schedule for the work, and the Contractor shall revise the schedule at appropriate intervals as required by the conditions of the work. Schedule information set forth above are estimates. The Contractor shall not be responsible for delays caused by circumstances outside the control of the Contractor.
5. Permits and Approvals. The Contractor shall secure and pay for the building permits, fees, licenses and inspections by government agencies necessary for proper execution and completion of the work. This responsibility is limited to building permits and, for the avoidance of doubt, does not extend to land use approvals, environmental permits, consumptive use permits, or other governmental approvals outside of building permits.
6. Contract Documents. Except as otherwise provided herein, the Owner shall furnish, at its expense, all necessary surveys, plans, drawings, approvals, easements, assignments, and changes required for the construction and use of the improvements. The Owner warrants the information, plans and specifications provided to the Contractor. The Contractor shall be entitled to rely on the plans and drawings supplied by the Owner; the Contractor warrants only that the work will conform to the design documents and shall have no responsibility or obligation arising out of design defects. The Contractor's warranties contained in this Contract exclude remedy for damage or defect caused by abuse, alterations to the work not executed by the Contractor, improper or insufficient maintenance, improper operation, or normal wear and tear.
7. Termination. The Contractor may terminate this Contract if the Owner fails to make payment as set forth herein and the failure continues for 10 days after notice, if the Contractor is unable to perform due to the failure of the owner to provide access to the site, necessary approvals, or its efforts to complete the work are frustrated by the actions or omissions of the Owner. In the event the Contractor terminates the Contract, it may recover payment for work executed, included reasonable overhead and profit, costs incurred by reason of such termination, and damages. No refund of payments made by the Owner shall be due as a result of termination under this section.
8. Governing Law; Venue; Attorney Fees. This Contract shall be governed by the laws of the state of Florida. Venue for any dispute arising in connection with this Contract shall lie exclusively in the court of appropriate jurisdiction in the county where the work is to be performed. The parties hereby irrevocably waive the right to a jury trial in connection with any matter related to or arising out of this contract or the work performed hereunder and consent to a bench trial in any such action. The prevailing party in any litigation shall be entitled to recover its reasonable attorneys' fees from the other party.
9. Assignment; Subcontractors. This Agreement may not be assigned without consent; provided, however that nothing herein shall limit the right of the Contractor to use subcontractors and contract labor in completion of the work. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the Contract may be assigned by the Owner to a lender providing construction financing if the lender has assumed the Owner's rights and obligations under the Contract.
10. Hazards. The Owner represents that, except as disclosed in writing, there is no hazardous condition, material or substance at the site of the work. The Owner shall indemnify and hold harmless the Contractor, its subcontractors, agents and employees from and against claims, damages, losses, and expense arising out of or resulting from performance of the work in the affected area if in fact, a hazardous condition, material or substance presents the risk of bodily injury or death and has not been rendered harmless, except to the extent that such damage, loss or expense is due to the fault or negligence of the party seeking indemnity. If, without negligence on the part of the Contractor, the Contractor is held liable by a government agency for the cost of remediation of a hazardous material or substance by reason of performing the work described herein, the Owner shall indemnify the Contractor for all cost and expenses thereby incurred.
11. Insurance; Beneficiaries. The Contractor shall maintain appropriate commercial general liability insurance and statutory worker's compensation insurance and will provide certificates of insurance upon the request of the Owner. The Owner shall be responsible for purchasing and maintaining the Owner's usual liability insurance and property insurance until the work is complete. This Contract has no third-party beneficiaries.
12. Consequential Damages. The Owner waives claims against the Contractor for consequential damages arising out of or relating to this Contract. This waiver includes damages incurred by Owner for rental expenses, for losses of use, income, profit, financing, business and reputation, and for loss of management or employee productivity or of the services of such persons. This waiver is applicable to damages due to termination.
13. Entire Agreement; Modifications. This Contract, together with the information, plans, and specifications provided to the Contractor, constitute the entire agreement. Any previous agreements and understanding between the parties regarding the subject matter of this Contract, whether oral or in writing, are superseded by the Contract. Any amendments, modifications, or change orders must be in writing. Any change orders require the agreement of the Contractor and shall include appropriate modifications to the contract price to include the Contractor's cost of labor, material, equipment, and reasonable overhead and profit.
14. ANY CLAIMS FOR CONSTRUCTION DEFECTS ARE SUBJECT TO THE NOTICE AND CURE PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 558, FLORIDA STATUTES. 15. ACCORDING TO FLORIDA'S CONSTRUCTION LIEN LAW (SECTIONS 713.001-713.37, FLORIDA STATUTES), THOSE WHO WORK ON YOUR PROPERTY OR PROVIDE MATERIALS AND SERVICES AND ARE NOT PAID IN FULL HAVE A RIGHT TO ENFORCE THEIR CLAIM FOR PAYMENT AGAINST YOUR PROPERTY. THIS CLAIM IS KNOWN AS A CONSTRUCTION LIEN. IF YOUR CONTRACTOR OR A SUBCONTRACTOR FAILS TO PAY SUBCONTRACTORS, SUB-SUBCONTRACTORS, OR MATERIAL SUPPLIERS, THOSE PEOPLE WHO ARE OWED MONEY MAY LOOK TO YOUR PROPERTY FOR PAYMENT, EVEN IF YOU HAVE ALREADY PAID YOUR CONTRACTOR IN FULL. IF YOU FAIL TO PAY YOUR CONTRACTOR, YOUR CONTRACTOR MAY ALSO HAVE A LIEN ON YOUR PROPERTY. THIS MEANS IF A LIEN IS FILED YOUR PROPERTY COULD BE SOLD AGAINST YOUR WILL TO PAY FOR LABOR, MATERIALS, OR OTHER SERVICES THAT YOUR CONTRACTOR OR A SUBCONTRACTOR MAY HAVE FAILED TO PAY. TO PROTECT YOURSELF, YOU SHOULD STIPULATE IN THIS CONTRACT THAT BEFORE ANY PAYMENT IS MADE, YOUR CONTRACTOR IS REQUIRED TO PROVIDE YOU WITH A WRITTEN RELEASE OF LIEN FROM ANY PERSON OR

COMPANY THAT HAS PROVIDED TO YOU A "NOTICE TO OWNER." FLORIDA'S CONSTRUCTION LIEN LAW IS COMPLEX, AND IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT YOU CONSULT AN ATTORNEY

This agreement, executed this 11 day November, 2024, is Work Order No. 24-165 to Continuing Services Contract Engineering Services agreement between the City of Zephyrhills (hereinafter referred to as "City" or "Client"), and Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc., (hereinafter referred to as "Kimley-Horn" or "Consultant"), dated November 27, 2018.

WHEREAS, the City and the Consultant entered into an Agreement to provide Continuing Services for Engineering Services; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement provided that the City would make individual technical service requests of the Consultant; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the promises and mutual benefits which will accrue to the parties, it is mutually understood and agreed as follows:

I. General Scope of this Work Order

The Consultant will be responsible for providing professional and technical services as requested by the City. These services will focus on development of engineering and design plans for GoPasco Bus stops within the City of Zephyrhills City limits, as discussed in Section II.

The scope of work will include preparing a due diligence package for all six bus stops, with the initial set of construction documents to be developed for three (3) selected locations. The six candidate (6) sites identified for these bus stops are as follows:

1. US 301 & CR 54 (northbound)
2. US 301 & Daughtery Rd (southbound)
3. Gall Blvd & C Ave (northbound)
4. SR 54 & 3rd St (eastbound)
5. US 301 & N Dairy Rd (northbound)
6. 20th St & North Ave (northbound)

The Consultant will be responsible for ensuring that all necessary documentation and plans are prepared for these bus stop locations in accordance with the project requirements.

II. Scope of Work

The following scope of work is summarized as follows:

Pursuant to the City's request, Kimley-Horn has prepared the following Scope of Services for this project. Kimley-Horn proposes the following tasks to the City to provide Civil Engineering services for the requested bus stops.

TASK	DESCRIPTION
1	Due Diligence – Kimley-Horn will prepare a due diligence report for six (6) bus stop locations. A site visit to each site is included and a report will be provided on the 6 bus stop locations. The report will include recommendations for each bus stop location based on the site walk and field observations. (approx. 2-3 weeks)
2	Sub-consultant – MRIC – This survey will include an approximate surveyed area of 50' x 200' that will include topographic information, right-of-way, easements, above ground utilities, for three (3) preferred bus stops locations as listed above. Right-of-way lines shall be mapped from public records and field control. Elevations shall be collected in a manner sufficient to generate one (1) foot contours. Visible evidence of utilities shall be located. Associated easements shall be mapped per documentation. All trees and landscape area within the areas shall be located. All work shall be in accordance with the standards of practice as set forth by Chapter 5J-17 of the Florida Administrative Code. (2-4 weeks)
3	Civil Construction Documents – Kimley-Horn will prepare civil engineering Construction Documents for the three (3) preferred bus stops chosen by the Client in Task 1. These Construction Documents will include information for the existing horizontal control, and site paving and grading. Kimley-Horn will coordinate with GoPasco on details for the bus stops. This task assumes the existing stormwater system is sufficient for the site, and no modifications to the existing system will be required. Kimley-Horn understands that no modifications to the existing utilities are proposed. This task does not include preparation of electrical engineering plans associated with site lighting. (4 weeks)
4	Permitting – Kimley-Horn will prepare and submit, on the Client's behalf, the following permit applications, provide support in requesting approvals from the jurisdictions noted below. This task includes Kimley-Horn's attendance at one (1) FDOT Pre-Application Meeting. • City of Zephyrhills Site Development Permit • FDOT Access and Drainage Permit • Southwest Florida Water Management District (SWFWMD) Environmental Resource Permit Exemption (ERP Exemption)
5	Construction Phase Services – Kimley-Horn will make up to two (2) site visits per bus stop to observe the progress of the work. Observations will not be exhaustive or extend to every aspect of Contractor's work, but will be limited to spot checking, and similar methods of general observation. Based on the site visits, Kimley-horn will evaluate whether Contractor's work is generally proceeding in accordance with the Contract Document and keep Client informed of the general progress of the work. Kimley-Horn will not supervise, direct, or control Contractor's work, and will not have authority to stop the Work or responsibility for the means, methods, techniques, equipment choice and use, schedules, or procedures of construction selected by Contractor, for safety programs incident to Contractor's work, or for failure of Contractor to comply with laws. Kimley-Horn does not guarantee Contractor's performance and has no responsibility for Contractor's failure to perform in accordance with the Contract Documents. Kimley-Horn is not responsible for any duties assigned to it in the construction contract that are not expressly provided for in this Agreement.

III. Additional Services

The following are services that are not included in the scope of services, but can be provided as additional services if authorized by the Client. Compensation for additional services will be agreed to prior to their performance.

- Attendance at meetings with City and/or property owner
- Attendance at public hearings
- Additional reviews
- Stormwater Report and/or Modeling
- Additional Roadwork outside Limits of Bus Stop, (i.e. widening, turn lane, etc.)
- Maintenance of Traffic Drawings

IV. Information Provided by Client

The following information, upon which the Consultant can rely, shall be provided by the Client or the developer of the project.

- Selection of three (3) bus Stops from Task 1.

V. Compensation

The Consultant's fee for this project is summarized by work task and labor category on the attached Exhibit A. The cost for Tasks 1 through 5 will be a lump sum fee of \$42,635. The Consultant will not exceed this maximum fee unless they have received written authorization.

VI. Schedule

We will provide our services as expeditiously as practicable to meet a mutually agreed upon schedule.

VII. Other Provisions

All provisions contained in the Corridor, Sub-area, and Special Transportation Studies Agreement not specifically modified herein shall remain in full force and effect and are incorporated by reference herein.
